

PERMANENT RESIDENTIAL SINGLE-PHASE SERVICE (Rate 1)

Effective March 1, 2022

I. AVAILABILITY

Available to Members of the Cooperative located on its lines for all permanent residential dwellings which will be utilized for the only purpose of single-family residential occupancy and is subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Also available to Members with current service under this rate for facilities directly related to this dwelling including but not limited to barns, shops, residential water wells, and storage buildings. The capacity of single-phase individual motors served under this schedule shall not exceed 10 horsepower.

II. TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

III. PROTECTION

Adequate overcurrent protection of all motors shall be the responsibility of the Member. This protection shall be consistent with National Electric Code and any requirements of local government agencies having jurisdiction over Member's premises.

IV. NET RATE

Daily Service Charge	\$1.15 per Day, Single-Phase
All kWh	\$0.09222 per kWh

V. MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the greater of, the daily service charge multiplied by the number of days in the billing cycle or any contractual minimum agreement.

VI. WHOLESALE POWER ADJUSTMENT

The above charges shall be increased or decreased as determined under the Wholesale Power Adjustment WPA.

VII. ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE CHARGE

The Environmental Compliance Charge will be assessed on all energy (kWh) usage during each billing period. The Environmental Compliance Charge recovers actual and forecast the costs of complying with local, state and federal regulations and is subject to change.

VIII. DISTRIBUTED GENERATION (DG) CLAUSE

For accounts that have an interconnected distributed generation system attached to the Association's electrical distribution system, there shall be added to the total of all charges under this rate schedule an amount as determined in accordance with the Association's Distributed Generation Rider.

IX. TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, the gross rates being 5% higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within 15 days of the billing date, the gross rate shall apply, and the account is subject to be disconnected.
